Conditions of Entry

- Artworks, on loan to Condobolin HS will be insured by the health service from the 22 January 2019
- Insurance of works, when being transported to the hospital will be the responsibility of the artist.
- Artworks will be displayed from 22 January to 17 April 2019
- Artworks for this exhibition are to be photographs
- Artworks behind glass are preferred.
- All works must be framed by artist. It is preferable that d rings are attached to the back of the frames by the Artist. The tops of the D-rings needs to be greater than 6cm from the top of the frame.
- If the work does not have D rings on the back the artist gives permission for the installers to attach D rings. All care but no responsibility for damage to the frame or art work when installing D rings will be taken by the health service.
- Any work which is unsuitable to display in a hospital will not be hung.
- A sign will inform prospective buyers that the artworks are for sale through contacting the Arts OutWest Arts and Health Coordinator. Labels will not include price of the art work. If people are interested in purchasing artwork, the artist will be given the prospective buyer contact details.
- If works are sold they can be taken after 22 February 2019. Artists are requested to provide another work to replace the sold work.
