Trundle area artists invited to exhibit at MPS

Artists from the Trundle area are invited to make a positive difference to their health service by exhibiting works in the first art exhibition at Trundle Multipurpose Health Service (MPS).

The three-month long 'Totally Trundle' exhibition will feature artworks on the walls of the Trundle MPS from 6 November 2019 into the new year.

Artworks may be original photographs, drawings, paintings or weaving, preferably framed behind glass. Works may be listed for sale if the artists wish.

Artworks and entry forms must be delivered to Trundle Hospital reception on Monday November 4 and Tuesday November 5, 2019

The exhibition is organised by regional art development organisation Arts OutWest for Western NSW Local Health District as part of a new Arts Culture and Wellbeing Program at Trundle MPS. A similar program is also running at Condobolin Health Service. This first project at trundle is to develop an art space to display local artists work.
